Elementary Facts

- 365 Elementary students at the Market Street Campus (Pre K through 6th grade).
- Full/Half day preschool options. Full day Kindergarten.



- Students commute from all over the Portland/Vancouver area.
- Five acre campus with 4 classroom buildings, including an Arts Building with state-of-the-art Computer Lab, spacious Library, and fully equipped Art and Music Studios.
- Completely fenced-in, supervised playground with plenty of up-to-date play equipment.
- Specialist classes in Computer, Band, Art, Music, Library, and Physical Education.
- Both Traditional and Transitional 6th Grades available.
- Youth sports offered for 3rd- 6th graders including Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Baseball, and Softball.
- Before and After School care with options including athletics, science, languages, music, and chess, as well as summer programs.



The School

- Founded in 1947. Independent, Non-denominational, College Preparatory.
- 700 students in pre-school through 12th grade.
- Two separate campuses with many different programs.
- Accredited by the Northwest Association of Accredited Schools (NAAS) and the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI).
- Member of the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability.

- 94% of high school graduates attend college.
