

## College Applications

- Determine payment for application fees (or apply for fee waivers)
- Register on Common App or apply on college website
- Request transcripts
- Have someone proofread your essays
- Ask people for recommendations (teachers, work supervisor, pastor)
- Request test scores to be sent (if required)
- Schedule interview (if required)
- Keep track of where you are applying & what materials are needed for each school

Don't go in blind - Make sure it's the right fit

**Virtual Tours** - Most colleges offer online tours or videos to check out a campus before making the time and financial investment of traveling to the school.

**College Tours** - Schools offer group or individual tours for students and their support systems to see the college firsthand. While on campus ask to meet with a professor, attend an event, try-out for a team or performance group. You should plan to spend anywhere from one hour to half a day on campus.

**Campus Events** - Schools offer preview days or overnight events to allow students extended time to check out campus.

- $\star$  Ask Financial Aid questions
- **★**Audition/Try-out
- $\star$  Stay overnight
- $\star$  Drive around town
- $\star$  Schedule ahead for best scheduling
