

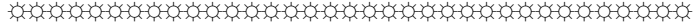

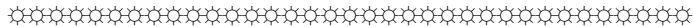

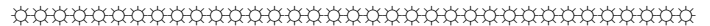

4 boxes of 24 Crayola\* crayons, non-washable  
2 packs of 12 colored pencils, **sharpened**  
1 pack of 24 colored pencils  
1 box of 10 fine tip Crayola\* markers  
1 Crayola\* water color paint set with brush (8 colors)  
4 soft pink erasers  
4 LARGE **white** glue sticks

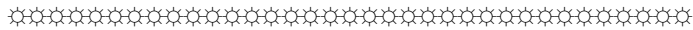

1 box of fine tip water based felt markers (Set of 10)  
1 box of broad tip water based felt markers (Set of 10)  
2 soft pink erasers  
48 (white) pencil tip erasers  
4 LARGE **white** glue sticks  
1 Elmer's\* glue, MEDIUM size (4 oz.)  
1 roll of Scotch\* tape  
1 pair of scissors-Fiskars\*  
1 12" ruler w/ metric (wood)  
1 **plastic** pencil box  
1 pack of fine tip black dry erase markers (4 per package)

## FIFTH GRADE

36 #2 Ticonderoga\* pencils, sharpened  
1 single-subject college ruled **SPIRAL** notebook  
1 Composition notebook  
3 two-pocket folders (no brads)  
2 large pink erasers and/or 1 dozen cap style erasers  
2 **LARGE** Elmer's\* glue sticks (no liquid glue)  
2 red pens  
1 box colored pencils, sharpened (12 or 24 count)  
1 yellow highlighter  
1 pair of scissors – (Fiskars\*- jr or adult size are best)  
1 12" ruler (inches and centimeters) - **hard rulers only**  
4 dry erase markers, thick (any color)  
3 pads of 3x3 post-it notes  
1 pack of baby wipes  
1 roll of paper towels  
1 box tissue  
1 1.5" binder with clear pocket on the front  
Calculator (not scientific, inexpensive, small)  
Reusable water bottle

### Optional Supplies

1 handheld pencil sharpener  
5 mechanical pencils with lead (student preference)  
1 box of thick markers (10ct) **OR** 1 box of crayons (up to 24ct)  
1 box of Ziploc\* sandwich bags (40ct) **OR** gallon size (19ct)

## Emergency Kits

### Emergency Kit Items

- 1 gallon Ziploc\* bag with child's name on it (all items below must fit into this bag)
- 3 x 5 card with child's name\*\*
- Letter of comfort (see below) with a family photo
- Rain poncho (can be purchased at Dollar Tree)
- Small flashlight & batteries or cyalume light stick (safe, nontoxic light source)
- Stocking cap
- Pair of warm socks
- Emergency space blanket
- Tiny toy or game

Food examples: granola bars, canned juices (boxes can get smashed), fruit cups, small packaged crackers, raisins, small bottle of water

**\*\*Name card should have a hole punched in the top with a safety pin attached. Back of card should list emergency information:**

**Name and address of child, child's age, home phone number & parent cell number, another contact person's name & phone number, medications taken, and allergies.**

### Sample Letter of Comfort

Dear (child),

Since you are reading this letter, there must have been an emergency while you were at school. Emergencies can be scary. The good thing is that they usually don't last very long. Things will get better soon. Please try to be brave and even as helpful as you can. We are trying to get to you so we can be together again. We love you and want to be with you. In order to get to you safely, we might have to come slowly and cautiously. You will need to be patient. Keep remembering how much we love you and that we are thinking about you every minute. Say your prayers often because that will help you too.
